I love thee, Lord Jesus, Look down from the sky, And stay by my cradle Till morning is nigh.






O LITTLE TOWN OF BETHLEHEM

JINGLE BELL ROCK


Jingle bell, jingle bell rock,

Up on the house top, click,click,click


